

LIFEGUARD (Seasonal)

(Part-Time/Full-Time) Hours /Shifts Vary: 5:45 am – 12:00 pm; 11:30 am – 4:00 pm; 3:30 pm – close. Closure varies depending on special events, swim meets, and rentals beyond close. Monday – Sunday Season begins May to September.

50-60 Positions Open

Overview:

The lifeguard is responsible for performing a variety of duties to prepare the pool for the demands of the group present to ensure safety at all times. Duties will include but not limited to: Cleaning of pool area, locker room and facility upon opening, during shift and upon closing. Place and remove lane lines and flags as necessary. Vacuum the pool. Pull out or remove equipment. Take and document pool reading as advised. Perform all job tasks within the rules and guidelines of the District's safety program. Complete a minimum of 4 hours of in-service training per month as specified by National Pool & Water park guidelines.

Qualifications:

- Must be 16+ years of age per Ellis Certification Course.
- Must attend Guard Academy and successfully complete and pass an in-water skills test, written test, and examination on lifeguard skills and safety.
- Must successfully complete CPR/First Aid Certification.
- Must have knowledge of pool rules and regulations.
- Must be able to work in a team environment and independently.

Training begins in May (evenings & weekends). Must be available to work full season.
