Dear Kensington Park Neighbors,

I hope you had an enjoyable winter and maybe we will start enjoying some spring like weather! I want to provide an update regarding the Kensington Park redevelopment. The project has basically been completed. There are still a few items to be completed and they are:

Completion of the Brian McGarry Memorial – two (2) park benches are to be installed. Recognition plaques will be mounted on the benches and a dedication boulder.

Continue improvement of park turf through a weed and feed program. Will slit seed if necessary (for the third time)

Portable restroom shelter:

Additional landscape to be added near east side of parking lot, at both side entrances and around the portable restroom shelter.

Continue to monitor the retention basin and reseed if necessary. Each year as the plant life matures; the area should become more full and scenic.

Seasonal Landscape Maintenance –Butterfield Park District has contracted out the weekly landscape maintenance and care to an outside contractor, Green Horizon. They will service the property on a weekly basis beginning April 21 and continue through October 13. Their regular day will be Thursday. At the conclusion of the season in the fall, they will perform “fall” cleanup on two dates at the end of October and the beginning of November. Butterfield Park District will still maintain the park throughout the year including trash pickup and care of the ball diamonds.

After sitting dormant for two seasons, the ball fields will be used in the spring and this summer. The Park District has permitted several local teams for use of the fields. Each group has been instructed to be respectful of the neighbors and the park. Response has been very cooperative.

Donation opportunities – the Park District would like to add park benches throughout the property. This is great opportunity to recognize a loved one or a special occasion by contributing a bench with a recognition plaque.

Dogs are welcome as long as they are on a leash. Please clean up after them and properly dispose of the waste.

There is no vehicular traffic (atv's, motorcycles, snow mobiles), no alcohol, no golf, no fireworks allowed in the park. The Park district will have zero tolerance regarding these acts.
