**Pool Passes**

Pool Passes are required for each camper attending K-5 Camp due to frequent swimming at the park district pool. Campers are not required to carry the pool pass with them when at camp. The pass will need to be purchased prior to the start of your child attending camp, either as part of a family pool pass or an individual camper pool pass. Pool Pass Fee: Camper \$45

**K-5 Code of Conduct**

As part of a community effort, the Butterfield Park District is proud to be a part of the Character Counts Program. Through this program we will promote the Six Pillars of Character: Trustworthiness, Respect, Responsibility, Fairness, Caring, and Citizenship. This will be the basis of appropriate behavior at all of our camps.

**Refund Policy**

In order to keep an accurate count of campers as well as stability within the program, the Butterfield Park District will grant refunds only under the following conditions: medical, or if on the first day of the session, the child does not feel camp is right for him/her. A phone call must be received promptly by the park district staff. The refund policy will be strictly enforced and there will be no credits or rollover days if a child misses camp.

**Important K-5 Camp Information**

- A K-5 Camp specific registration form must be used to register for camp.
- Additional field trip fees may be required throughout the summer.
- All camp forms must be completed and turned in to the office before campers can attend camp.
- Parent orientation Night will be Thursday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>, from 7:00-8:00pm in the Butterfield Park District Recreation Center's Activity Room.
- Parents must sign campers in and out at the pavilion. If weather is inclement, sign-in and sign-out will be inside the recreation center.
- Each camper is required to have a pool pass due to daily afternoon swimming. An individual camper pool pass can be purchased for \$45 in cases where there is no family pool pass.
- There is a 20% discount for siblings in K-5 and Teen Camp (discount applied to the youngest siblings).
- THERE ARE NO CREDITS OR ROLLOVERS IF A CHILD MISSES CAMP.
- You are only registered for the weeks for which you have paid. Your child will not be able to attend camp if payment has not been received prior to the start of each weekly session.
- An Extended Care option is available for 7:00-8:30am and/or 3:30-6:00pm time periods.
- If you would like your child to participate in other programs offered this summer through the Park District, during camp hours, our camp staff will be happy to make sure your child gets where they need to go. Classes available include: Basketball Camp, Cooking Classes, Tennis, Swim Lessons, Theater Camp, Gymnastics, Spanish and more! 20% discount on certain Park District programs.
