For example, a current 5th grader would be placed in the 6th Grade Concert Band.

Summer band will take place in the air-conditioned band room of Glenbard South High School from Monday, June 20th thru Friday, July 1st. The combined band performance for the baseball game will take place at Elfstrom Stadium in Geneva on Thursday, June 30th at 6:30pm. Both groups will perform a concert at Glenbard South on Friday, July 1st at Noon.
